

## Athletic Code of Conduct

It must be understood by all students and their parents/legal guardians that to participate in the Riverside Brookfield Athletic Program is a commitment to follow the rules, regulations, codes of conduct, policies, and procedures established by the school for the implementation of its athletic program. It must also be understood that students who violate these rules, regulations, codes of conduct, policies, and procedures shall face disciplinary action. In addition to these categories, student athletes will be held responsible to the RBHS Student Handbook and IHSA rules.

All athletes and parent/guardians sign the Athletic Permit Card stating that they have read the Athletic Code of Conduct as listed in this Athletic Handbook or the Riverside Brookfield Athletics website and agree to disciplinary action if not followed.

<b>Category A Offenses:</b> Being present at an occasion where illegal consumption, purchase or sale of alcohol, steroids, tobacco, drugs, look-a-like drugs, or drug paraphernalia occurs.	- Suspension from one tenth of an athletic season's competitive play - Parent notification - Ten hours of school or community service	- Suspension from one half of an athletic season's competitive play - Mandatory parent meeting with Athletic Director	- One year suspension from all RBHS Athletics
<b>Category B Offenses:</b> Illegal possession, consumption of tobacco, alcohol, steroids, drugs, look-a-like drugs, or drug paraphernalia.	- Suspension from one half of an athletic season's competitive play - Fifteen hours of school or community service - Mandatory parent meeting with Athletic Director	- One year suspension from all RBHS Athletics	- Suspension for the remainder of the athlete's high school career
<b>Category C Offenses:</b> Permitting the use of alcohol or other illegal or inappropriate chemical substances in one's residence.  Purchasing or supplying alcohol or drugs.	- One year suspension from all RBHS Athletics - Mandatory parent meeting with Athletic Director - Twenty hours of school or community service	- Suspension for the remainder of the athlete's high school career	N/A

Please note that punishment per season will carry over to the next season if not able to be completed during the season in which the offense occurred. This Athletic Code of Conduct is enforced year-round, even when classes are not in session.
